Position/Title	Energy Policy Coordinator (Coal and Just Energy Transition)
Goal of Position	Inform and coordinate with the members of CAN Europe on relevant energy transition-related policy issues, with a special focus on justice of energy transition and reducing the burden for consumers
Main Functions & Responsibilities	Policy process monitoring and dissemination: Support member and partner organizations, in the development of energy transition policies that would mitigate the social adverse impacts (Just Energy Transition) Support member and partner organizations, in the development of energy transition policies concerning just transition in coal regions Gather intelligence and follow up EU policy and coal energy sector development and positions of EU member states; energy market developments that impact final energy prices; relevant EU Funds and instruments designed to alleviate social cost Support advocacy and outreach on energy-transition-relevant EU policies – in coal-dependent EU Member States and beyond Prepare research, briefings and papers for policy makers – especially on Fossil Fuel Subsidies and Just Energy Transition Implementation of the multi-stakeholder and networking cooperation processes: Organise internal events and external meetings and workshops with EU stakeholders, incl. outreach and networking -with a focus on energy transition in the CEE region, help support the CSOs' coordination and their involvement into the European debates and policy making processes Conduct regular communication with national and regional actors to provide an update and exchange on the relevant policy developments at the EU level and nationally Support the coordination of production, dissemination, and communication of publications Coordination of network positions and strategies: Develop an overarching narrative, strategies and tactics to accelerate a coal phase-out in the EU and beyond, Convene regular Working Groups, organise internal events and external meetings and workshops with EU stakeholders:
